For everyone, mark:

Births, adoptions, marriages, divorces.
 Arrivals and departures from U.S. (of any kind).
 LPR dates. Naturalization dates. Visa expiration dates.
 Residences, moves, entering school, leaving school, graduations.
 Arrests, incarcerations, deportations/removals.

Naturalization: FIVE (five) sparkly-“clean” years.

Naturalization exemption from English:

FIFTY (50) years old plus TWENTY (20) years of LPR status *OR*

FIFTY-FIVE (55) years old and FIFTEEN (15) years of LPR status.

Cancellation of Removal: TEN (ten) years.

DACA: Go back to January 2007 or person’s 15th birthday, whichever is EARLIER.

School records, diplomas, report cards, certificates, class photos, programs from school events, athletic or academic trophies, or prizes. Dates of standardized tests.

Notes from teachers. **Vaccination and other medical records,** records from emergency rooms or clinics, bills/invoices/statements, records from dentist and eye doctor, optician, receipts for eyeglasses. **Religious** records, baptism, reconciliation /confession, First Communion, Confirmation. **Library cards, swimming certificates.**

Signatures of applicant on her/his own and other people’s marriage certificates.

Traffic tickets, truancy notices. Family photographs, especially combined with affidavits by persons present when photographs were taken, explaining the event and date.

Electric, gas, cable, phone bills, and receipts. Mail sent to applicant at U.S. address, especially with dated postmarks. If nothing bad in there, Facebook.

Use yellow highlighter to highlight names and dates on documents.
